Commissioner Keelty is a career police officer with more than 30 years experience at local, national and international levels. He is the first Commissioner appointed from within the ranks of the Australian Federal Police (AFP).

Since his appointment as AFP Commissioner in April 2001, Commissioner Keelty has led the expansion and transformation of the organisation, with major new responsibilities for Counter Terrorism, Aviation Security and Transnational Crime.

He has also overseen the creation of the International Deployment Group - a regional assistance and capacity building initiative - which has already undertaken missions in the Solomon Islands, East Timor, Papua New Guinea and the Middle East.
