

Keynote Address

Hon Colin Barnett MLA

Colin was elected to the Western Australian Parliament in August 1990 after a career in industry and academia. From 1985 - 1990 Colin was executive director of the Western Australian Chamber of Commerce and Industry.

Colin was Leader of the Opposition and Leader of the Parlimentary Liberal Party from February 2001 to March 2005.



During his period as Minister, some \$35 billion of resources and energy investment occurred. Major projects included the Goldfields gas pipeline, Collie Power Station, Mid West gas pipeline and the first iron ore processing plant at Port Hedland.

Colin was responsible for the highly successful privatisation of AlintaGas and the Dampier to Bunbury gas pipeline, the introduction of the underground power project for Perth and a number of alternate energy projects.
