KEYNOTE SPEAKERS



Professor Andrew Hopkins
Australian National University

Andrew Hopkins will make two presentations at the Safety2006 Conference.

His keynote address "A Critique of 'Acceptable' Risk" will focus on a critical view of the way risk management is sometimes seen as a matter of driving risk down to some pre-determined numerical level regarded as acceptable or tolerable.

His second presentation, "Organisational Culture and Safety: the Exposures of F111 Maintenance Workers to Toxic Chemicals" will demonstrate how the culture of an organisation can impact on safety using a particular case study.
