**Hon. Norman Moore MLC - Minister for Mines and Petroleum
*Government of Western Australian***

Norman Moore was elected to the Legislative Council in 1977 and was appointed Minister for Mines and Petroleum; Fisheries; and Electoral Affairs on the election of the Liberal-National Government in September 2008.

Since his appointment to the Mines and Petroleum portfolio, Minister Moore has overseen big improvements to the State Government approvals processes for resources exploration and development. This has resulted in increased certainty for industry, attracted resource project investment and increased the economic benefits for all West Australians.

The Minister has also initiated the single biggest overhaul of the mining industry's occupational health and safety system, lifted the previous ban on uranium mining and helped the State move towards increased energy security and improved standards of living.

The Hon Tom Koutsantonis MP is the Minister for Manufacturing Innovation and Trade, Minister for Mineral Resources and Energy and Minister for Small Business and also is the chair of the State Government's Competitiveness Council. He was elected to the South Australian State Parliament in October 1997, was the presiding member of the Economic and Finance Committee from 2006 – 2009 and appointed to the Ministry in March 2009.

**Dr Haksoo Kim - Director, Fuel Supply
*Exelon Generation Company LLC***

Dr Haksoo Kim is the Nuclear Fuel Supply Director for Exelon Generation Company - which is the largest Nuclear Utility in the United States. He is responsible for the procurement and management of nuclear fuel for Exelon's seventeen nuclear units.

Dr Kim is a graduate of the Seoul National University with a Bachelors degree and a Ph.D. degree from the University of Wisconsin in nuclear engineering. He has worked in the Nuclear Fuel Department within Exelon Generation Company for over 25 years and has extensive experience in nuclear fuel procurement, contract management, fuel economics, and reactor safety analysis.

He holds a Senior Reactor Operator (SRO) certification for Braidwood Nuclear station. He is also currently a World Nuclear Fuel Market (WNFM) Board of Governors.

Dudley Kingsnorth - Professor
Centre for Research in Energy and Minerals Economics & The Industrial Minerals Company of Australia Pty Ltd

Dudley Kingsnorth has over 40 years experience in the international mining industry. He is recognised as a world authority on the rare earths market and rare earths project development through his 20 year association with the industry, initially as Project Manager of the Mt Weld Rare Earths Project and over the past 11 years as an independent consultant to the industry. He is the author/editor of the last four editions of the Roskill report on rare earths.

Mark Whitwill - Head, Out of Core
Kernkraftwerk Gösgen-Däniken AG

Since January 2010 Mark has been Head, Out of Core, at Kernkraftwerk Gösgen-Däniken AG (KKG) in Switzerland. KKG is the owner and operator of a 1,035 MWe PWR located some 50 km west of Zurich.

Mark heads a department responsible for all nuclear fuel cycle front end procurement, including uranium, conversion, enrichment and fuel fabrication. He is also responsible for back end activities including spent fuel storage, reprocessing and high level waste management.

Prior to joining KKG, Mark was a senior consultant for NAC International and manager of their Zurich operations. Before moving to Switzerland, Mark started his career in the nuclear industry working for the CEBG in England, as a fuel buyer, including several years in the British Civil Uranium Procurement Organisation.

Armin Orichel - Senior Executive
RSB Logistic

Armin Orichel joined RSB LOGISTIC in 1985 (formerly known as Reederei und Spedition Braunkohle), a part of the RWE group of companies, one of the biggest German utilities.

In 2003 the nuclear transport activities were excluded from RWE's core business and since then RSB is part of the Kieserling group of companies, a medium size German transport company with its headquarters in Bremen Germany.

In 2009 he was promoted Senior Executive within RSB and has also been chairman of the transport working group of the World Nuclear Association, the biggest interest group in the nuclear industry worldwide, since 2008.

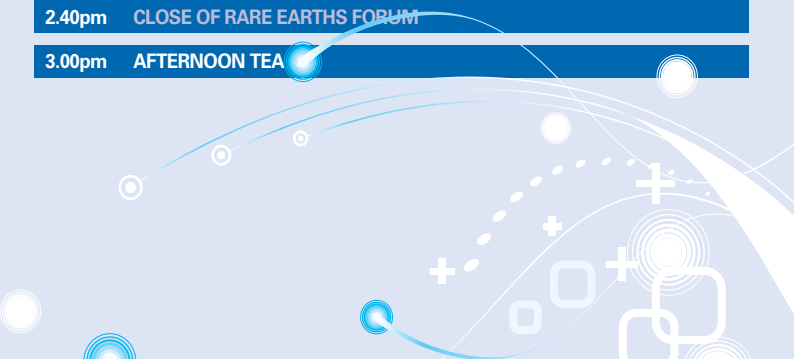
